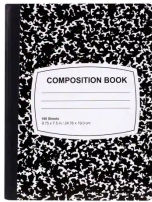
Math

English Language Arts and History

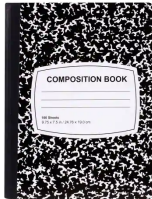
- 2 composition notebooks
